### **NEW BRUNSWICK ENERGY AND UTILITIES BOARD**

Headquartered in Saint John, the New Brunswick Energy and Utilities Board (NBEUB) is seeking a board member. The NBEUB consists of five full-time members appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council (LGIC) for a term of ten years. The LGIC appoints one member as Chairperson and CEO and another as Vice-Chairperson. The current vacancy exists due to the impending retirement of the Chairperson and CEO.

Established under the Energy and Utilities Board Act, the NBEUB is the regulating body for New Brunswick's electricity and gas markets and provides regulatory oversight of the transmission and distribution of electricity, natural gas, pipelines and the motor coach industry. It also administers the weekly price regulation of petroleum products such as gasoline, diesel and furnace oil. Its mandate is to ensure that service providers charge reasonable rates and provide reliable service to the people of New Brunswick.

Functioning in a quasi-judicial nature, the independent Board balances the interests of both the regulated entities and the public, ensuring that operations function in a fair and reasonable manner. The Board holds public hearings concerning regulated rates and services at which interested parties may question witnesses, present evidence and make submissions.

The ideal candidate will be a self-directed, collaborative individual with a background in accounting, engineering, business or law who possesses analytical skills and a commitment to the public interest. Bilingualism would be a definite asset.
